
The Apostles share the gospel message with the Jews Acts 7: Stephen stoned by the Jewish Leaders Acts 8: Message taken to the Samaritans Acts 9: Saul encounters God on the Road to Damascus / name changed to Paul Acts 10-11: Message taken to the Gentiles Acts 15: Council at Jerusalem The believers led by the Spirit concluded:

- Gentiles are not to be unnecessarily burdened by the Mosaic regulations and law; they need only abstain from immorality and idolatry - Effectively, they said, being Christian does not hinge on first becoming Jewish.
- The law cannot save, only by grace and faith in Jesus can a person be saved.
 Paul was God's apostle to the Gentiles, with a special ministry to the church

Judaizers wanted the believers to follow the Jewish laws and customs of religious holidays, special dietary requirements, circumcision etc... and they were saying that unless they did this they weren't saved.


This was not the good news: the gospel of grace and mercy, a gospel of faith in Jesus.

FAITH AND BELIEF IN AUSTRALIA DEFINED




*When given a 'spiritual but not religious' option, 14% of 'Total Christianity' moves to this new category.




